I was attracted by it, walked inside, and stood alone in a figure room, asking me where to go, what to do, perseverally lost. And then, my cell phone shook. à € "hi, trace. It's Dad. » It looked just like he did when he called me. when we talked every day. when he was here. à€ "dad, it is you! à€ "I froze unbelief. I didn't even want to breathe for fear of doing something that would end this moment. I wanted to ask him where he was, but I knew it already. I started crying. I love you, Dad. I wish you were here. I miss you so much. »I felt like I couldn't take another step without him. as I couldn't do it alone. à€ "also à€" he said. à€ "I'm right here. and I could hear it. his presence. His love. I could feel it with me. And suddenly, I was fine. I had a deep knowing I would find my way. lost more. even when the dream ended a moment later and I woke up still crying, turning it back so much and knowing it was with me. It's still. Right here. one after the next. signs and dreams continued, the blessed reassuring that nothing can separate us completely from each other. Not even death. he does not end the lack of his physical presence, wishing to be able to ask for his advice, but it is a huge comfort in the midst of it. If you miss someone, I want you to know - even if you have no signals and dreams - that your person is close. I know it's not the same thing before. It's not a hug. It's not a conversation. It's not the things we miss, the things we're used to for a long time. butThat we lose so deeply I am here in the holy kind of love that never dies. The kind of love connects us again. The film tells the story of two twenties-year-old drug smugglers, David Packouz and Efraim Diveroli, who end up winning a \$300 million contract from the Department of Defense to become arms traffickers in Afghanistan, only to ruin it by selling illegal and cheap arms and ammunition. But the film is inspired by a true story, as War Dogs is based on the book Arms and the Dudes. How did this crazy story come about?The book, written by Guy Lawson, is an expansion of a Rolling Stone article that Lawson wrote in 2011. The article, "The Stoner Arms Dealers: How Two American Kids Became Big-Time Weapons Traders", is where the story of David Packouz and Efraim Diveroli, along with a third accomplice, Alex Podrizki, first entered the spirit of pop culture. Their exploits had been reported previously, particularly in 2008 in the New York Times, but Lawson's article was the first major attempt to uncover the full story. Lawson continued to research history for several years, publishing his extremely detailed 288-page account as Arms and the Dudes: How Three Stoners from Miami Beach Became the Most improbable Gunrunners in Hstory in 2015.Click here to buy As far as the differences between Lawson's article and his book are concerned, his book is simply much more It's detailed. It also sheds more light on Podrizki, which in the opening article is a bit more of a rethink than Packouz and Diveroli. It's practically the Superman of dogs, but maybe it's a little too perfect.7TogoThe latest Disney dog is, Togo, a real sled dog who has all obstacles to bring medicine through tundra in a desperate village of Alaska. the dog is a hero in history and on the big screen.8HoochAt first glance, look,It's a terrible dog. He's untidy, he's dirty, and he's definitely destructive. But it is also one of the most loving and faithful cinematographic dogs ever, willing to lie down in life to save another.9Shadow and Chancethe Homeward Bound Duo will stop without anything to gather with the family they love, showing the kind of loyalty that everyone should hope in a dog.
